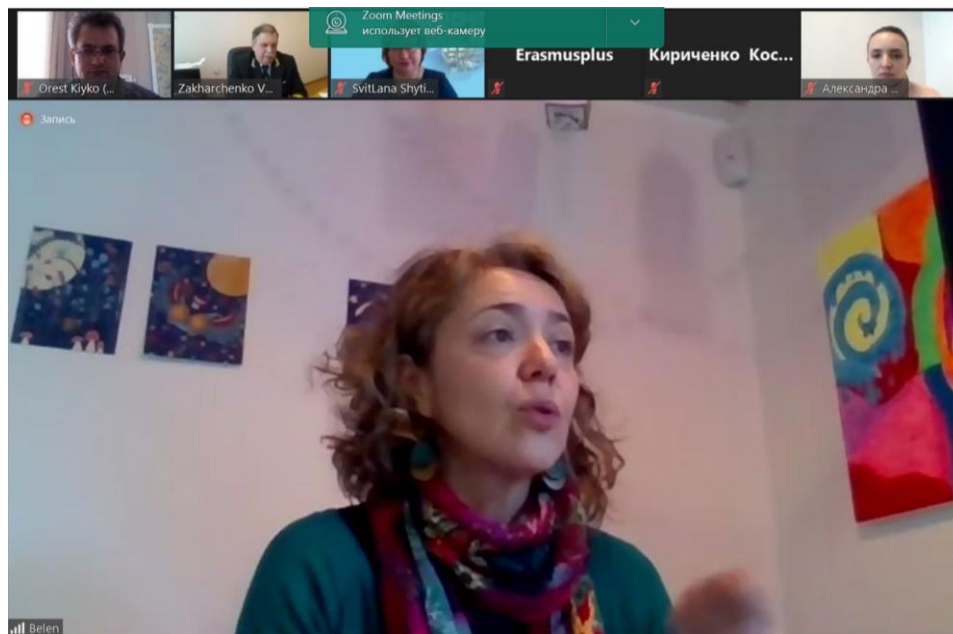


## Monitoring mission

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**MESU role in the project**


