

Training at Jagiellonian University in Krakow

From 3rd to 7th September, 2024 the training for staff members of Ukrainian partner institutions was held at Jagiellonian University in Krakow.

The event was organized under the leadership of Dr. Marek Frankowicz (Jagiellonian University, QUARSU project coordinator) and Prof. Dr. Vadym Zakharchenko (Vice Rector of National University “Odessa Maritime Academy”, QUARSU project national coordinator Ukraine).
